Good afternoon,

We have some <u>MORE GOOD NEWS</u> to share about the <u>22 COVID-19 tests</u> administered on <u>Thursday, February 25, 2021</u>. Health Services has confirmed that:

- 21 tests returned negative
- 1 test remains pending
- 0 positive tests!

The pending test is being processed through the local Quest lab and will take a few days. This student will remain in quarantine for close contact until the results are available. All other students and employees have been cleared to end their quarantine for close contact. Students are being notified now that they can leave quarantine housing and return to their residential assignment.
