While vaccinations remain a personal choice, the College strongly encourages members of the community to receive the COVID-19 vaccine when it is available to them. The majority of Landmark College employees live in either VT, NH, or MA, and each state has their own guidelines.

It has been brought to our attention that NH residents are seeing swift vaccination appointments. It may be due to the NH vaccination guidelines eligibility as related to "...staff of a residential facility for persons with....developmental disabilities" – Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder, Autism Spectrum Disorder, and Learning Disorders are covered under that definition.
